The Oklahoma City-County Health Department reports amenity-type pools may operate, provided they can effectively comply with the general social distancing guidelines in place during each phase of the "OURS-Plan"- cap bather load/capacity at 50% of normal approved maximum and prohibit groups/gatherings within the pool area of 10 or more people, and individuals/family groups separated by at least 6 feet. Hard surfaces must be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized frequently to prevent the transfer of the virus via these surfaces. In the case compliance with these restrictions is infeasible or cannot be achieved due to lack of cooperation by patrons or other issues, it is advisable that the facility remain closed until compliance can be achieved and maintained, or until all restrictive measures are lifted. Although it is still recommended that people wear face masks in public to help prevent/slow the spread of the virus, these masks should not be worn in the water, as it may cause respiratory distress when wet.

The Sequoyah Place swimming pool will open for the season Saturday, May 23, 2020 and will be open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. through Monday, September 7, 2020.

Until further notice, the pool will operate under the following guidelines:

- 1. The Sequoyah Place pool is restricted to residents only. No guests are permitted.
- 2. Pool capacity is reduced to 13. No more than 13 residents inside the pool area at one time.
- 3. Individuals/family groups must be separated by at least 6 feet.
- 4. NO glass containers, beer bottles, or food are allowed in the pool area.
- 5. Only proper swimwear will be permitted. No jeans, cut-offs, etc. will be permitted.
- 6. No diapers are allowed in the pool. This is a **State Law**.
- 7. Children under the age of 15 years must be accompanied by an adult (18+).
- 8. No pets are allowed inside the pool area.
- 9. Please respect the pool equipment and chairs provided by the Association. You are responsible for any damage you cause.

We hope that everyone will do their part to keep our neighbors healthy and safe and maintain the benefit of our neighborhood pool.
